

Patient Collection Instructions:

5-Hydroxyindoleacetic Acid (5-HIAA), 24 Hour, Urine

NOTE: Some prescription medications could interfere with test results. Your provider should decide if any medications should be stopped and inform you when they should be restarted.

For <u>48 hours before</u> patients start their urine collection **and** <u>during the 24 hour collection period</u> follow all diet information below.

1. Limit the following to 1 serving per day:

Fruits, vegetables and nuts

2. Avoid eating any of the following:

Avocado, banana, eggplant, kiwi, pecans, pineapple, plums, tomatoes, and walnuts

3. Avoid drinking any of the following:

Caffeine and/or alcohol

If clinically feasible, discontinue the following medications at least <u>48 hours before</u> specimen collection and <u>during the 24 hour collection period</u>.

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol or generic versions)
- Aspirin
- Antihistamines
- Cough syrups
- Cold, sinus and flu medications
- Nicotine (cigarettes, gum and patches)
